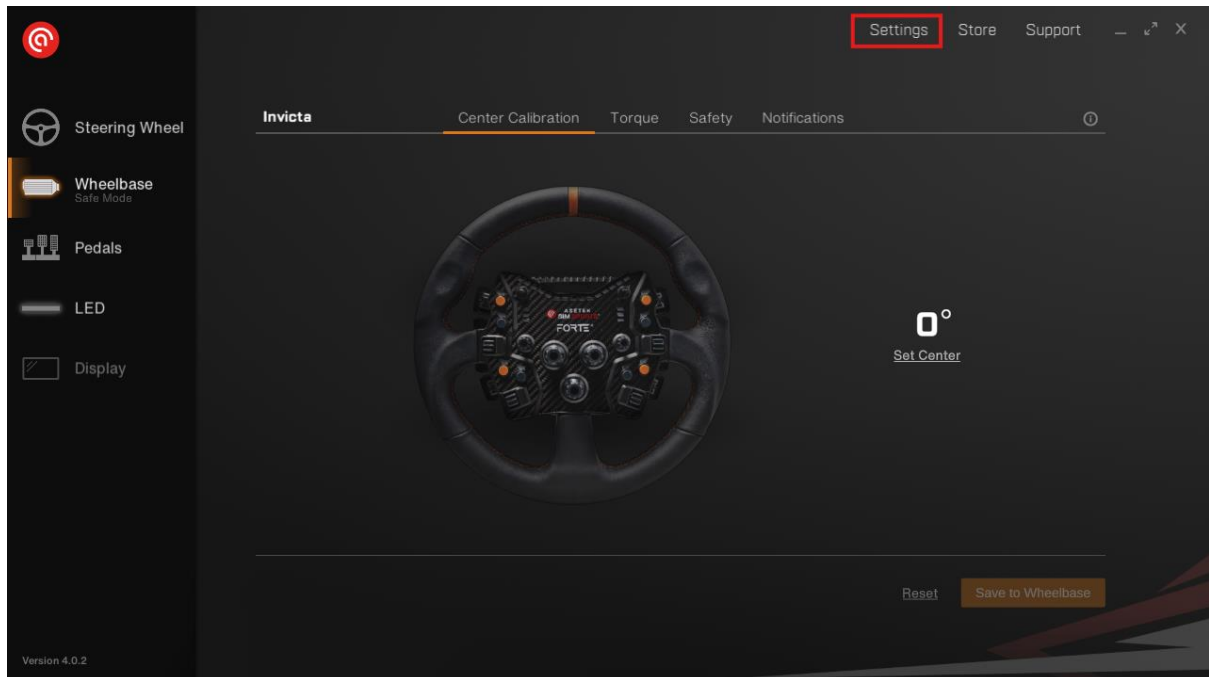


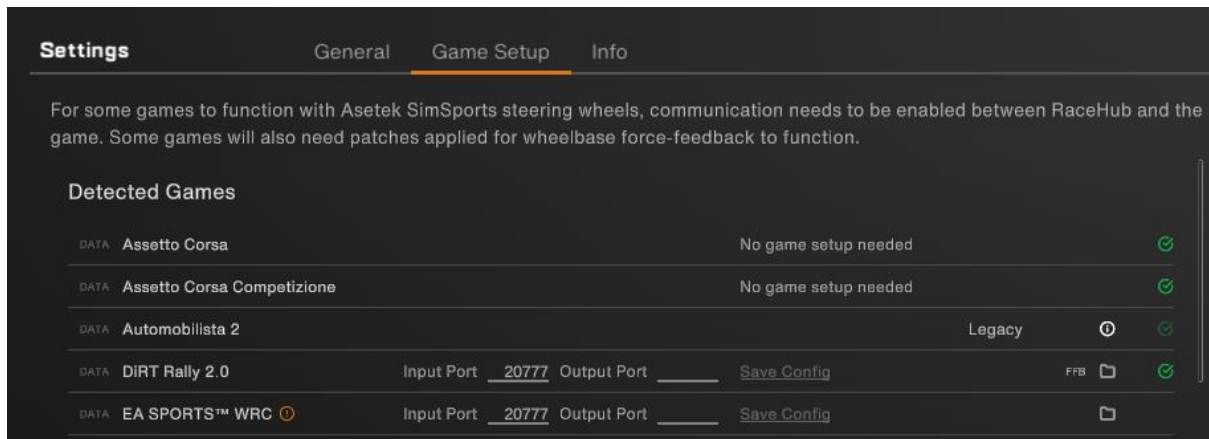
Input Guide – WRC

To ensure all files are created in the game folder, launch the game then close it when reaching the main menu.

Go into Racehub and click on settings on the top right corner.



go into Game Setup and go down to WRC.



Set your input port and output port to ensure channeling the game data to reserved for Racehub usage.

If you have other equipment that requires UDP data, please ensure that the input start above the output set in Racehub e.g input 20777, output 20800.

The above photo shows the input port only and missing the output port

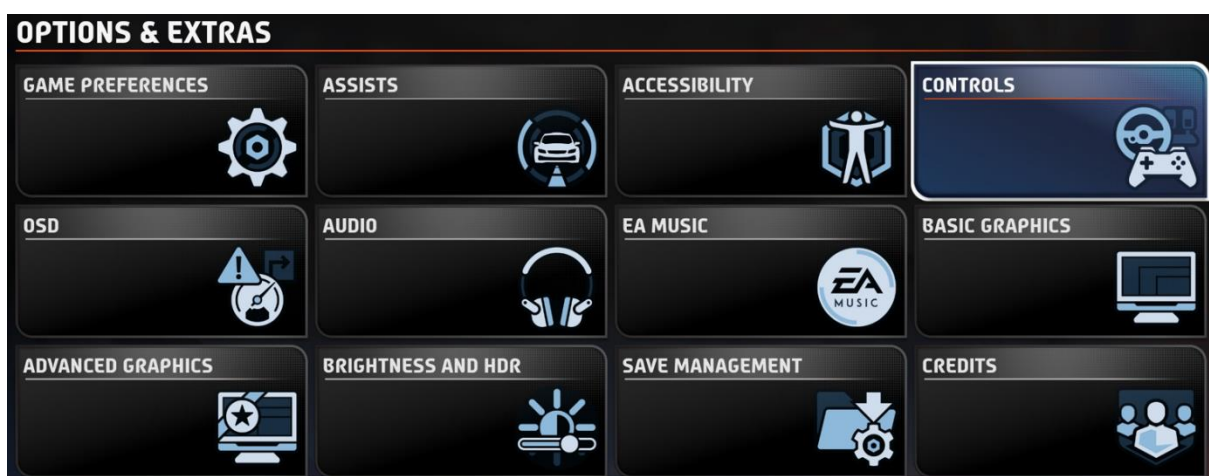
Add the FFB function to the game folder, by clicking on the “FFB” writing. (for reference see the FFB writing on DiRT Rally 2.0 above EA SPORTS WRC)

The FFB writing will disappear after being pressed.

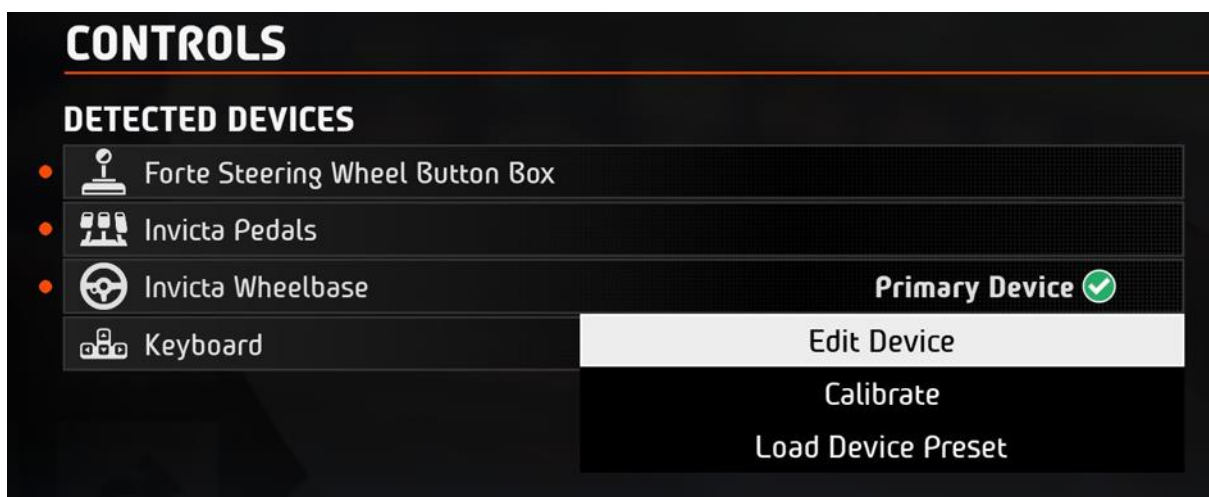
Start the game.

When you are on the main menu, press the F1 button on your keyboard to open “Options & Extra”-menu

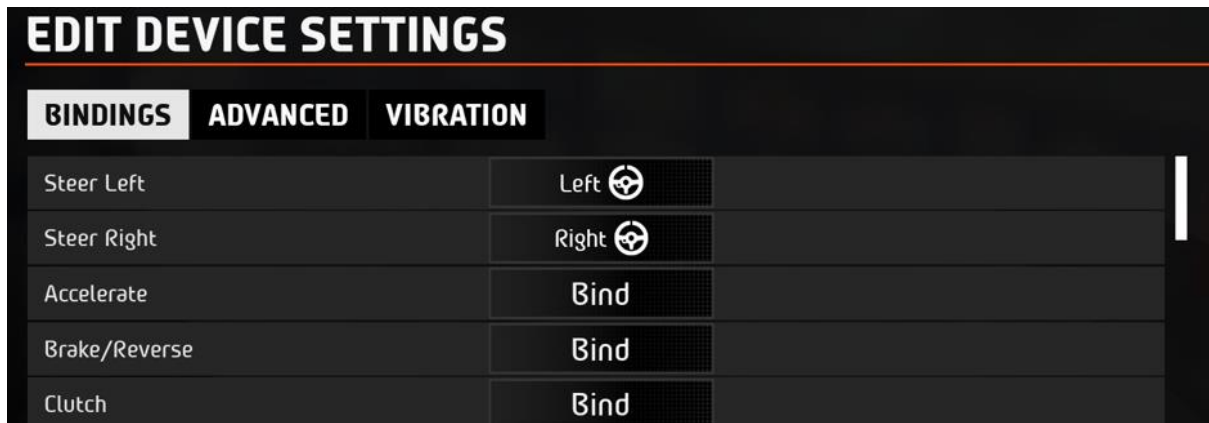
Go to “Controls”



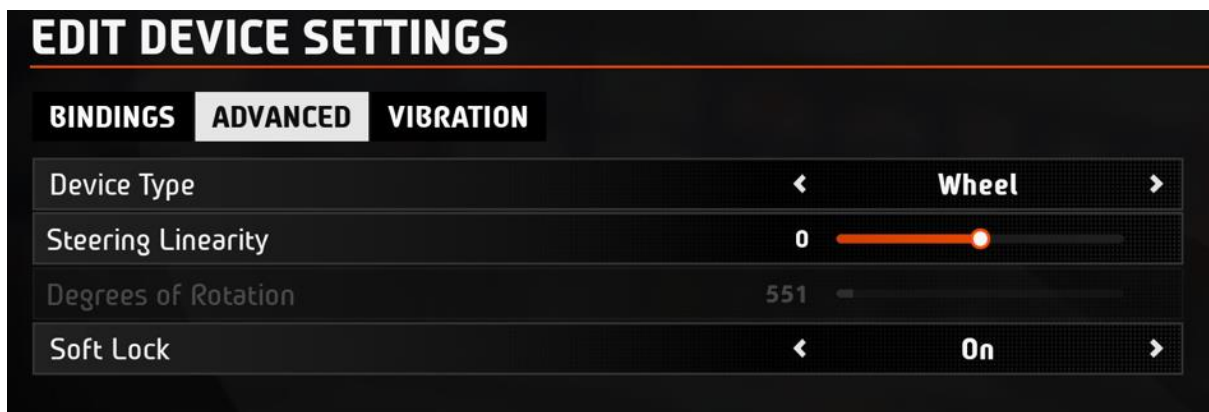
Click on your wheelbase, and press Edit Device.



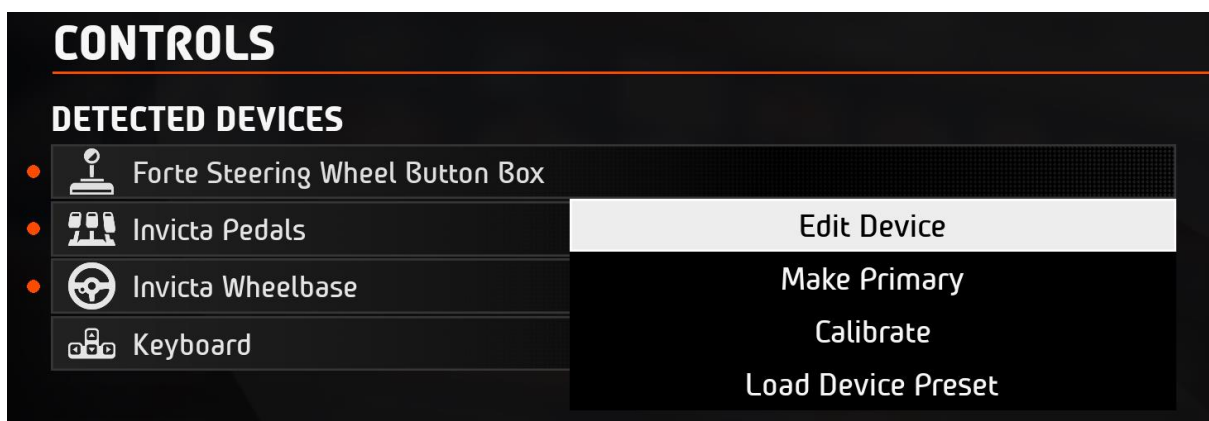
Bind your left and right axis by following the guidance



Go to Advanced folder, and select "Wheel"

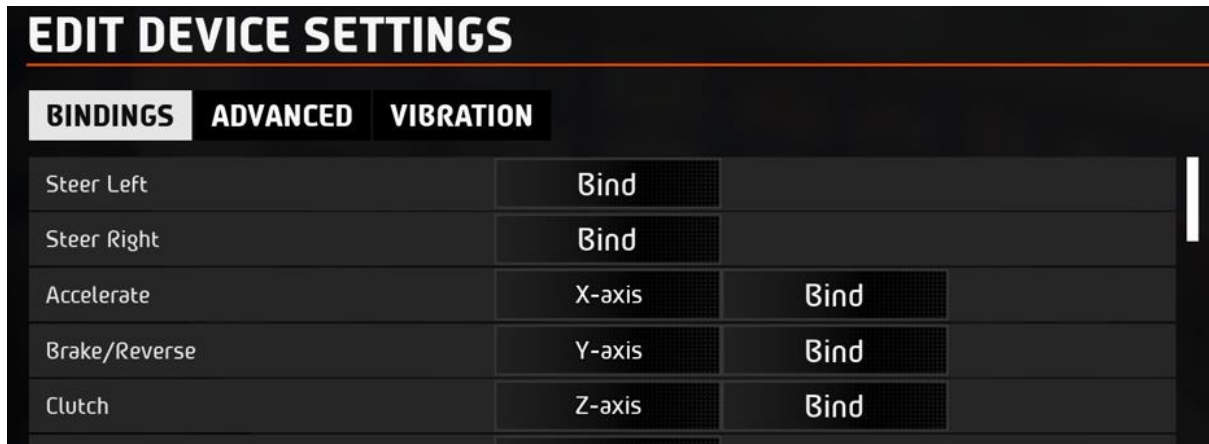


Set up your pedals by going back to the equipment menu and select the pedals.

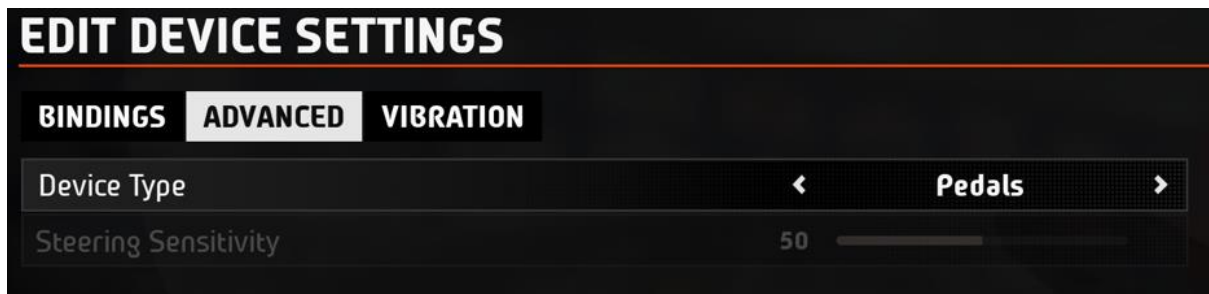


press "Edit Device"

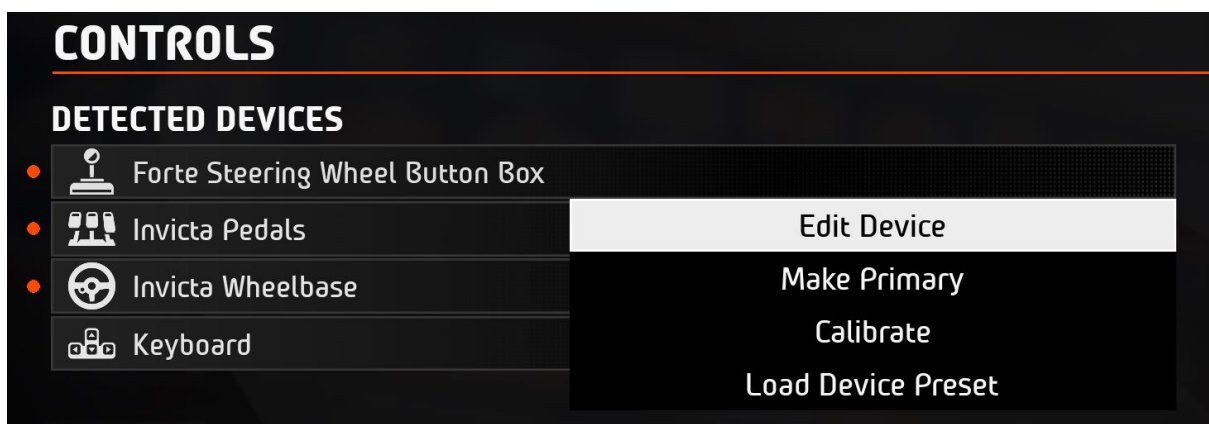
Bind axis for your accelerate and brake and clutch if any as your pedals



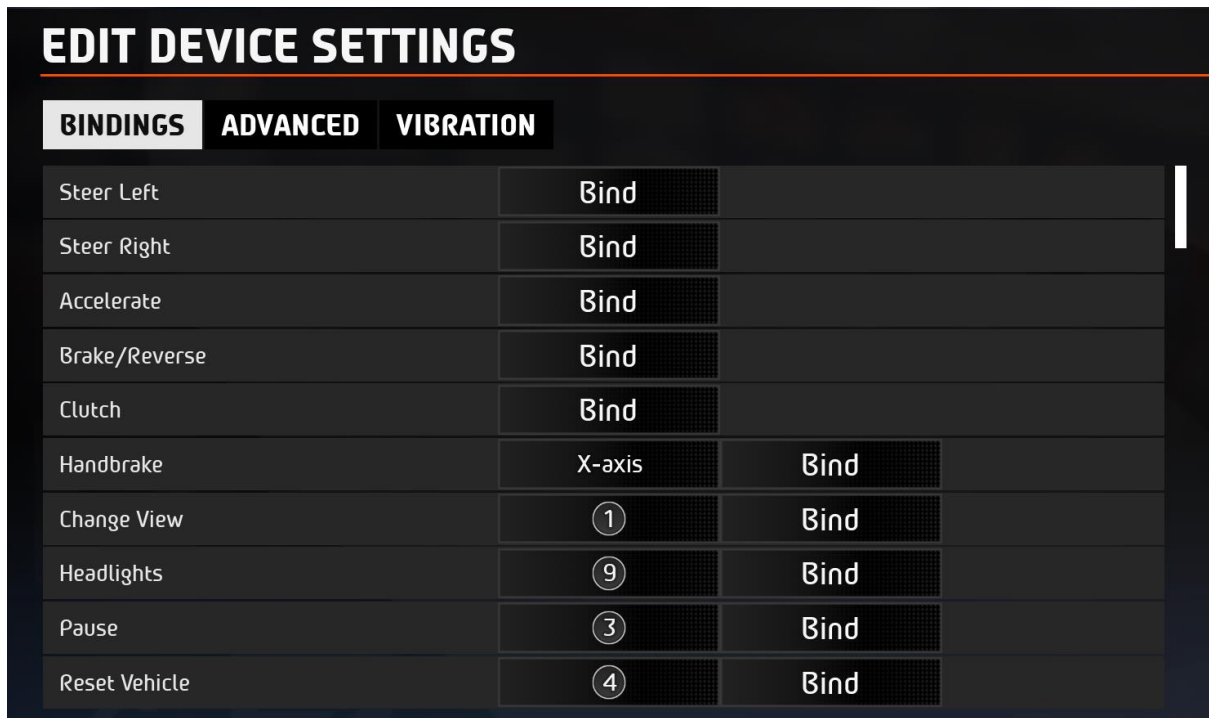
Go to "Advanced" and ensure they are set as pedals.



To set up your wheel, go back to the equipment menu and select your steering wheel.
Press Edit Device.



Bind your sequential up and down, and all the buttons as features you want in the game



Go to “Advanced” and put the wheel as Joystick.

Your equipment are set and you are now ready to race!
